

#### 2025 MULES NATIONAL SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION

The Wednesday Morning Senior Golf League was developed to promote golf, meet others, have fun and play the game of golf according to USGA rules. The Association is open to any male age 50 or older.

Included in this packet is a pre-planned weekly event schedule starting March 12, 2025 and ending November 12, 2025. This 2025 event schedule is subject to change.

Annual membership fee is \$65.00. <u>Make checks payable to: SENIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION</u>. Annual fee breakdown:

- \$27.00 U.S.G.A. Handicap System
- \$38.00 League Dues

Senior Golf Association weekly fees:

- Mules National Members: \$5.00 for payouts and hole prizes; \$1.00 for skins
- Non-Members: Green fee \$17.00, Cart fee \$13.00, \$5.00 for payouts and hole prizes, \$1.00 for skins

Senior Golf Association members are required to sign up for the next week play in advance (no later than Tuesday – Noon) on the sign-up sheet or by phone in the pro shop. We do have a weekly meeting held fifteen minutes prior to scheduled playing time. This meeting is for announcements and discuss any golf rule issues or changes. For example, 8:00 AM start, meeting will be at 7:45 AM.

Part of your Association fee is for U.S.G.A. Handicap System. This is a software package to track your scores and provides a handicap that is used for pairings, net events, tournaments, and championships. It is your responsibility to record your golfing rounds using this provided service. The computer in the pro shop is yours to use. Effective 6-15-2025, all members must have <u>an established GHIN handicap to receive prize winnings in any net individual or team event, league championship, or President's Cup</u>. These measures were created to eliminate any discontent within the senior league regarding handicaps.

Hole-N-One's during league sponsored play will receive \$50.

\*The Pro Shop Staff will be responsible for posting all Wednesday league scores this year. It will be your responsibility to post scores from play other than on Wednesdays. After league rounds, turn in your score card to the pro shop where it will be handled accordingly. Please make sure the score card is neat and legible to avoid any confusion.

The senior league plays by U.S.G.A. and all local rules. It is important that each member understands these golfing rules, producing positive and consistent interpretation of the rules when questions or issues arise between players or groups. Without exception, all putts must be holed out, no gimmie putts. We will play the ball up one grip length everywhere, except out of bounds, hazards, sand traps, and greens. Senior League defines hazards as <u>ALL</u> un-mowed native grass areas whether marked with red stakes or not (this also means that the ball must be played as it lies in all un-mowed native grass areas).

In this packet is an information sheet. **Please be sure to fill in all information, most importantly, your tee box choice.** The desire of the Senior League is for everyone to play from the Grey Tees. However, we want our membership to enjoy the game of golf, therefore, our senior league will play from either Grey Tees, Red Tees, or Combo Tees.

Members must stay at tees selected at start of season unless they notify the pro shop that would like
to change. We would prefer you not change more than once during the season, but it is allowed. It is
important for the Pro Shop to know what tees you are playing from to assign the correct handicap for
pairings and flighting for that day's event. (your course handicap changes based on what tees you are
playing)

#### Senior Golf Association League Championship

June 18th and June 25th, 2025

The Senior League Champion will be the low 36-hole GROSS score and must play from the Grey Tees. Grey tee players will have three flights and red tee/combo tee players will have two flights. Each flight will have both gross and net divisions, the player will cash in whichever division he finishes the highest.

All players must play on the designated dates, both with an 8 AM start (weather permitting).

Pairings for June 18<sup>th</sup> are based on your handicap. Pairings for June 25<sup>th</sup> are based on your score from your June 18<sup>th</sup> round.

Cost: \$10.00 for entry fees by each player will be paid on the first day of the club championship to help build prize fund. \$5.00 of the entry fee will go to the League Championship and \$5.00 will go to the weekly prize payouts on June 18<sup>th</sup> and June 25<sup>th</sup>. If you can only play one of two championship dates, you would pay the \$5.00 entry fee for the prize money for that day's event. \$1.00 skins will also be collected on each date. Prize payout in each flight will be in cash, and hole contests in gift certificates.

For Mules National non-members, Green Fees of \$17.00, and Cart Fees of \$13.00 will be collected each date.

All USGA and local rules apply. All putts must be holed, no leather or gimmies allowed.

### Senior League President's Cup Championship

Ryder Cup type format. The four lowest handicap league players will be team captains. Captains will select their teams on Wednesday, September 24th.

Matches will be played on Wednesday, October 1th and Wednesday, October 8th.
